THE RIC CONFIRM WORKS COMMENCE ON ORTHODOX CHURCH SITES

The Reconstruction Implementation Commission for Religious Sites in Kosovo (RIC) confirm today that five companies have been given site possession to eleven Orthodox church sites in Kosovo. These companies are in the process of mobilisation and site set up to implement the works for protection and consolidation measures. This is in direct response to the first round of tenders issued by the Reconstruction Implementation Commission (RIC).

These sites are:

St Nicholas, Prishtine/Pristina;
Episcopal St George, Prizren
Church St. Parasceve, Donja Sipasnica
St Parasceve, Viti/Vitina
St Elias, Bistrazhin
Assumption of the Holy Virgin, Gjakova/Djakovica
St Lazar in Piskote
St Nicholas, Fushe Kosove/ Kosovo Polje
St Michael, Obiliq/Obilic
Presentation of the Holy Virgin, Lipjan/Lipljan
St Florus and Laurus, Lipjan/Lipljan,

The RIC have agreed the appointment of supervisors who will be responsible for the day to day running of the works and will be reporting directly to the Commission. The RIC are evaluating the second round of tenders this week.
